Read the following text and then answer the questions which follow.

Unemployment in Tunisia in 2018

- 1. The weak economic growth, the persisting economic difficulties and the delay in executing structural reforms did not help, over 2018, to meet the main challenge that Tunisia has been facing up for several years, that is the absorption of a high structural unemployment.
- 2. In fact, the unemployment rate has been 15.5% since 2016, corresponding to about 645 thousand job seekers. This rate is worse for higher education graduates, constituting the most vulnerable category with an unemployment rate of 28.8% in 2018.
- 3. Women are facing more difficulties than men to be integrated in job market with an unemployment rate of 22.9% against 12.5% for men. The indicators are even worse for rural women.
- **4.** Moreover, the inadequacy between job seekers' educational background, on the one hand, and enterprises' needs, on the other hand, are the main factor of unemployment persistence, aside from the weakness of net job creation which did not exceed 27.6 thousand job positions, that is just 4.3% of the total number of job seekers.
- 5. Consequently, and given the high unemployment level, two active programs have been put into application by the Government for several years in order to resolve this problem. The first one is devoted to training and integration of job seekers in working life. The second one aims at promoting independent work. These different programs are characterized by a wide range of instruments which target, basically, the reduction of young people's (between 15 and 24 years) unemployment rate which came to 33.4% in 2018.
- 6. Nonetheless, this persisting high unemployment rate requires deeper reforms of the job market, specially the business climate's improvement, establishment of an encouraging legal framework for private initiative, simplifying the measures and approaches which encourage the transition from the informal sector to the formal one.
- 7. The government should also improve the industrial and logistical infrastructure, which is likely to reduce regional disparities.

- 8. It is also essential to further focus on improving the quality of both education and the learning system.
- **9.** Overall, active employment policies should target, more particularly, young university graduates, women and other poor areas where the unemployment rate reached dramatic levels. As a consequence, a new National Employment Strategy (NES) was launched in June 2019 and will cover the 2020-2030 period. It aims at adapting both higher education graduates and professional training graduates to the evolution of the job market needs through a series of programs, accompanying mechanisms and budgets. In this program, the private initiative encouragement is a priority.
